Situation Report of Malaria Outbreak & Flooding JIMMA |

Waiting for intervention

Overview

The outbreak of Malaria is spreading in both rural and urban areas of Oromia Zones and towns. Jimma town and woredas are the most affected areas of the zone and the situation is getting worse as the disease is spreading fast. From 190,139 sample tests, 32,561 people were found affected by malaria(October 09,report). Currently, **Medical Supplies(chloroquine, Artesunate injection), Spray &, SBC(community awareness)** are the most urgent need identified. Mosquito bed(አጎቢር) is provided by government health office. Flooding affected people are still waiting for support as they lost their lands/farms was destroyed, around 400 houses were damaged, 2120 people are displaced. This report did not include food insecurity alert to be occurred due to delayed intervention.

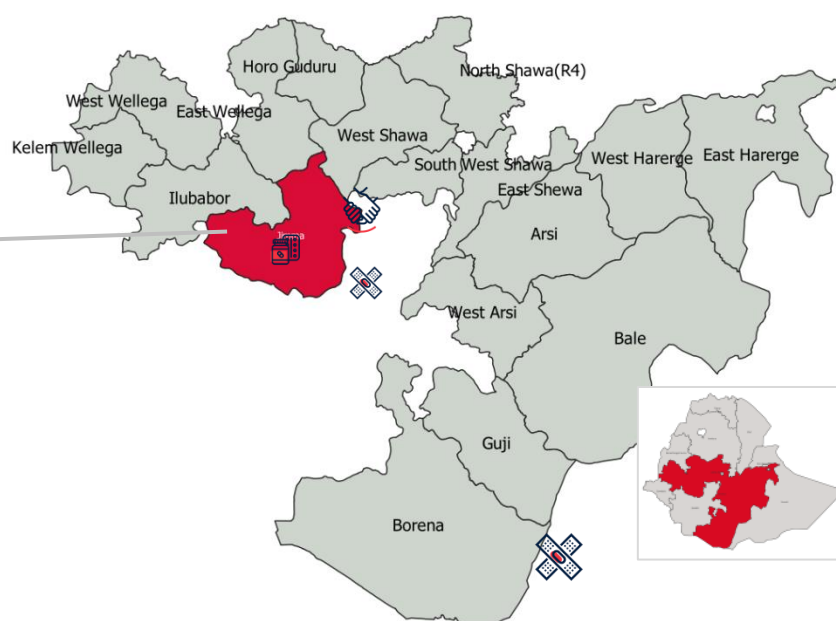
