Situation Report of Malaria Outbreak JIMMA | **Intervention NEEDED**

Overview

The outbreak of Malaria is spreading in both rural and urban areas of Oromia Zones and towns. Jimma town and woredas are the most affected areas of the zone and the situation is getting worse as the disease is spreading fast. From 190,139 sample tests, 32,561 people were found affected. Currently, **Medical Supplies(chloroquine, Artesunate injection)**, **Spray & SBC(community awareness)** are the most urgent need identified for around 241,609 community of the Jimma zone . Mosquito bed(አጎቦር) is provided by government health office.

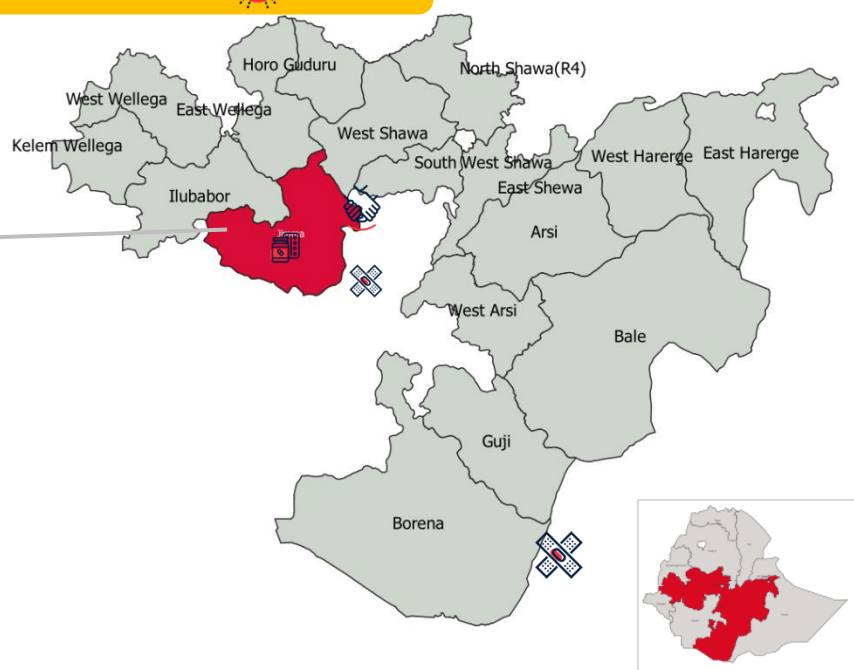
