About 641,782 peoples have been affected by floods and the overflow of lakes following the kiremt rain in the various regions of Ethiopia. The affected regions are Oromia, Amhara, South central Ethiopia, South West Ethiopia and Somali regions, as well as in Afar and Gambela regions. Therefore, immediate humanitarian aid is required for communities affected by the floods.

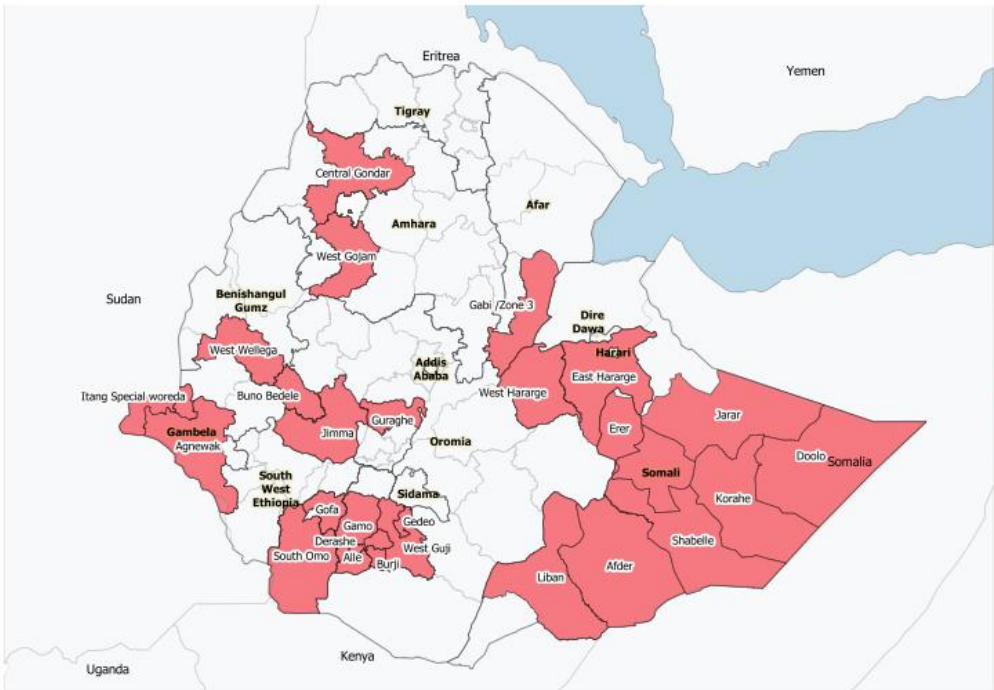

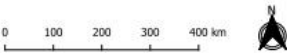


Map of flood affected areas
